This show is sanctioned by the American Dairy Goat Association and its rules shall govern. Only ADGA, American Goat Society, and Canadian Goat Society registered, recorded, or applied for animals may be shown.

1. This show is sanctioned by ADGA for the following breeds. **Sr. Doe:** Alpine, LaMancha, Nigerian Dwarf, Nubian, Oberhasli, Saanen. AOP (Sable, Toggenburg), Recorded Grade **Jr. Doe:** Alpine, LaMancha, Nigerian Dwarf, Nubian, Oberhasli, Saanen, AOP (Sable, Toggenburg), Recorded Grade **Buck:** (Saturday shows only) Alpine, LaMancha, Nigerian Dwarf, Nubian, Oberhasli, Saanen, AOP (Sable, Toggenburg). Breeds will be shown in the order listed.
2. Junior Doe and Senior Doe divisions are separately sanctioned.
3. **Entry fees:** \$10.00 per goat for any one show; \$18.00 per goat for any two shows; \$25.00 per goat for any three shows; \$30.00 per goat for all four shows. If you are showing in all four shows, your buck entries for two shows will be discounted to \$15 per goat total for the two Saturday shows. **While there is no entry deadline, early entries are appreciated, additions &/or substitutions will be permitted.** Pens (8'X8') will be available (with first hay bedding only) for \$10.00. *Exhibitors with a large number of animals or unique pen requirements should contact Karen Smith as soon as possible to make special arrangements.* Extra hay bedding may be available at an additional charge. 4. The base date for computing age is May 16, 2009 for the Saturday shows and May 17, 2009 for the Sunday shows.
5. Registration papers are required for all animals six (6) months or older A stamped duplicate application will be accepted for animals under six months of age.
6. Following South Carolina health rules, all goats must be listed on a Health Certificate issued within thirty (30) days of the show date by a licensed and accredited veterinarian, certifying the animals to be free of symptoms of contagious, infectious, or communicable disease. Unless the goats originate from a Certified-Accredited Herd, the Health Certificate must also indicate that all goats older than six (6) months on the show date have been tested and found to be free of Tuberculosis and Brucellosis within thirty (30) days. Goats which are native to herds in South Carolina need not be tested for Tuberculosis and Brucellosis. Testing is not required if herd is from TB free state or is certified TB free. Veterinarian issuing the Health Certificate must indicate on certificate that herd originates from a free state or is a certified herd.

7. There is a \$20.00/day RV hook-up fee.
8. Animals will be allowed on the grounds beginning at 6:00 PM, Friday, May 15, 2009. Goats must be identified on health papers by their name and tattoo. All health papers will be checked at check-in. The Show Committee reserves the right to ban any goats appearing to have contagious health issues from the premises.
9. Animals pre-entered and pre-paid must be on the grounds Saturday, May 16, 2009, by 7:30 AM; Show Secretary must be notified of any changes to entry form by 8:00 PM, Wednesday, May 13, 2009. All other animals must be on the grounds by 6:30 AM, Saturday, May 16, 2009, to have health and registration papers checked. First ring judging will begin with Alpine Senior Does at 8:00 AM; judging in the second ring will begin with Showmanship at 8:00 AM followed by Alpine Senior Does. Use the entry forms for showmanship classes, indicate showmanship in the breed column.
10. No Horned Animals may be shown. No Bicycles will be allowed in barn. All dogs present must behave appropriately. The Show Committee reserves the right to ban unruly or unhealthy dogs from the premises.
11. Barn lights will be turned off at 10:00 PM Friday and Saturday nights.
12. There is no mandatory pre-show milk-out.
13. Exhibitors are encouraged to wear white shirts without herd names or logos with white or black pants/skirts should be white or black.
14. All exhibitors are responsible for their property. Neither SCDGA, Inc. nor T. Ed Garrison Arena will accept responsibility for lost, stolen or damaged property.
15. No milk shall be dumped onto the grounds or into the drainage system; a milk dump station will be provided.
16. The fee for a 12'X12' vendor space is \$50.00 per day or \$75.00 (each) for vehicle or trailer space. Please make a note of your request on the entry form.
17. No vehicles are allowed in the barn except in case of emergency.

Additional Information:

1. Directions to show site: From 1-85 take Exit 19 (Hwy 76) toward Clemson, go about 7 miles & turn LEFT onto W. Queen St. T. Ed Garrison Arena is about a mile on your LEFT, Cattle Complex is to the RIGHT behind the big arena. Watch for signs.
