This show is sanctioned by the American Dairy Goat Association and its rules shall govern. only ADGA, American Goat Society and Canadian Goat Society registered, recorded or applied for animals may be shown.

1. This show is sanctioned by ADGA for the following breeds: Sr. Doe: Alpine, LaMancha, Nigerian Dwarf, Nubian, Oberhasli, Saanen, AOP (Toggenburg & Sable), and Recorded Grade; Jr. Doe: Alpine, LaMancha, Nigerian Dwarf, Nubian, Oberhasli, Saanen, AOP (Toggenburg & Sable), and Recorded Grade; Buck: Nigerian Dwarf, Saanen, AOP (Alpine, LaMancha, Nubian, Oberhasli, Toggenburg & Sable). Breeds will be shown in the order listed.

2. Junior Doe and Senior Doe divisions are separately sanctioned.

3. Entry fees: \$10.00 per goat for any one show; \$18.00 per goat for any two shows (\$9.00/goat/show); \$25.00 per goat for any three shows (\$8.33/goat/show); \$30.00 per goat for all four shows (\$7.50/goat/show). If you are showing does in all four shows, your buck entries for two shows will be discounted to \$15.00 per goat for both Saturday buck shows (\$7.50/goat/show). Pens (approx. 8'X8') will be available with first bedding for \$10.00. Extra bedding will be available at an additional charge. Exhibitors with a large number of animals or unique pen requirements should contact Karen Smith as soon as possible to make special arrangements. No tack pens. While there is no entry deadline, early entries are appreciated, additions and/or substitutions are permitted. Make checks payable to "South Carolina Dairy Goat Association, Inc." As an incentive to encourage attendance, we are offering one free pen per exhibitor who sends in their entry form and fees postmarked by May 1st.

4. Use entry form for Showmanship classes. Indicate Showmanship in the breed column, with exhibitor's name and age if under 19 years. All animals in Showmanship classes must be entered and shown in regular breed classes. There is no fee for Showmanship classes.

5. The base date for computing age is May 14, 2011, for the Saturday shows and May 15, 2011, for the Sunday shows.

6. Registration papers are required on all animals six (6) months of age or older. A stamped duplicate application will be accepted on animals under six months of age, if issued within 30 days of show day.

7. Following South Carolina health rules, all goats must be listed on a Health Certificate issued within thirty (30) days of the show date by a licensed and accredited veterinarian, certifying the animals to be free of symptoms of contagious, infectious, or communicable disease. Unless the goats originate from a Certified-Accredited Herd, the Health Certificate must also indicate that all goats older than six (6) months on the show date must have been tested for Tuberculosis and Brucellosis. Testing is not required if herd is from TB-free state or is certified TB free. Veterinarian issuing the Health Certificate must indicate on certificate that herd originates from a free state or is a certified herd.

8. Animals will be allowed on the grounds beginning at 6:00 PM, Friday, May 13, 2011.

9. Goats must be identified on health papers by name and tattoo. All health papers will be checked at check-in. The Show Committee reserves the right to ban any animals appearing to have contagious health issues from the premises.

10. All animals must be on the grounds by 7:00 AM, Saturday, May 14, 2011 (for Saturday Shows), or 7:00 AM, Sunday, May 15, 2011 (for Sunday Shows); to have health and registration papers checked.

11. Saturday judging will begin in the first ring (Show 1) with Alpine Senior Does at 8:00 AM; judging in the second ring (Show 2) will begin with Showmanship at 8:00 AM, followed by Alpine Senior Does when Alpine judging is completed in the first ring. Sunday judging will begin in the first ring (Show 3) with Alpine Senior Does at 8:00 AM; judging in the second ring (Show 4) will begin Alpine Senior Does when Alpine judging is completed in the first ring.

12. No horned animals may be shown. No bicycles will be allowed in the barn. All dogs present must be listed on the health certificate and behave appropriately. Dogs must be in crate or on leash at all times. The Show Committee reserves the right to ban unruly or unhealthy animals from the premises.

13. There is no mandatory pre-show milk-out.

14. Exhibitors are encouraged to wear white shirts without herd names or logos. Pants or skirts should be white or black. Flip-flops and shorts are discouraged.

15. No vehicles are allowed in the barn except in case of emergency. Trucks and trailers will be allowed in the barn for brief periods while unloading animals and tack. Please move your truck to the parking area as soon as possible to allow room for other exhibitors to unload.

16. No milk shall be dumped onto the grounds or into the drainage system; a milk dump station will be provided.

17. There is a facility charge of \$20.00/night hook-up for any camper or trailer connected to the facility utilities (ie: water and/or electric).

18. All exhibitors are responsible for their own property. Neither SCDGA, Inc. nor T. Ed Garrison Arena will accept responsibility for lost, stolen or damaged property.

19. Barn lights will be turned off at 10:00 PM Friday and Saturday nights.

20. The fee for a 12'X12' vendor space is \$50.00 per day or \$75.00 (each) for vehicle or trailer space. Please make a note of your request on the entry form.

21. The Jameson Inn, 128 Interstate Blvd, Anderson SC will be our official motel. \$49.99+tax/night. Phone 864-375-9800

22. Directions to show site: From I-85, take Exit 19 toward Clemson. Go about 7 miles and turn LEFT, onto W. Queen St. T. Ed Garrison Arena is about a mile on your LEFT. Cattle Complex (show barn) is to your RIGHT behind the big arena. For those wishing to use their GPS, the Garrison Arena address is: 1101 W. Queen St. Pendleton SC 29634. Note: some GPS's show W. Queen St. as Fants Grove Rd.

23. We will have supper for exhibitors Friday evening at \$5.00 a plate. Please indicate on entry form how many plates you will need so we will have enough food available.
